Safe Child Policy

The Correctionville Library is a public space welcome to patrons of all ages, but at no time will the library assume responsibility of minor, unattended children. All children under the age of 6 years must have a parent or caregiver present in the building at all times. A caregiver, assigned by the child's legal guardian, should be 13 years or older who has physical and mental capacity to care for the child should an emergency arise. Children between the ages of 6 and 8 years should not be left unattended for more than one hour.

In the event a child under 6 years old is left unattended or a child aged 6 to 8 is left unattended for more than one hour, the staff will attempt to contact a parent, guardian or caregiver. If a parent, guardian or caregiver cannot be located within one half hour, or if the library is closing, the Woodbury County Sheriff's Department will be called to assume responsibility for the child.
